Hurricane Checklist

It is impossible to predict when the next hurricane will affect your area, PLEASE BE PREPARED!

Hurricane Kit

- 1. Flashlight and Extra Bulbs
- 2. Battery operated radio
- 3. NOAA weather radio
- 4. Large battery-operated lanterns
- 5. Plenty of extra batteries
- 6. Plastic garbage/storage bags
- 7. Battery or windup clock
- 8. Working up to date fire extinguishers
- 9. Battery operated TV
- 10. Scissors
- 11. Extra cloths and raingear

House Checklist

- 1. Get all your supplies early in the season
- 2. Stow away loose outdoor objects
- 3. Trim dead branches from trees. Do this task before a storm has been announced
- 4. Use shutters or board up windows. DO NOT USE TAPE
- 5. Move furniture and valuables away from windows. Cover with plastic sheeting or plastic
- 6. Put important documents in plastic pouches
- 7. Get cash from ATM. You may not have access after a storm



Hardware

- Craftsman handtools (lifetime warranty) such as screwdrivers, hammers, shovels etc.
- 2. Power tools such as Craftsman power drills and screwdrivers with extra batteries
- 3. Sheets of exterier plywood for emergency repairs
- 4. Fasteners such as screws, nails along with rope and gloves
- 5. Duct tape and canvas tarps
- 6. Assortment of nails

Power Equipment

- 1. Craftsman generaters. See sales associate for optaining the proper size for your needs
- 2. Gasoline powered chain saw
- 3. Extra 5 gallon fuel cans
- 4. Fuel preservative
- 5. Gas grill with extra propane
- 6. Plastic sheeting and duct tape

Baby Needs

- 1. Disposable diapers, wipes
- 2. A 5 day supply of food and/or fomula
- 3. Don't forget the comfort items such as ointments and petroleum jelly
- 4. Baby medications

Food and Water

- 1. Bottled water
- 2. Packaged juice and milk
- 3. Canned fruits, meats etc
- 4. Cerela, prepared foods that need no refrigeration
- 5. Snacks and goodies
- 6. Canned sodas and drinks
- 7. Raw vegetables and bread
- 8. Dried fruits, sugar, salt and pepper
- 9. Stock up NOW. Do not wait for a storm to be announced
- 10. Plenty of 5 day coolers
- 11. Crank up the fridge to max before the storm hits
- 12. Clean your tub with bleach and fill with clean water

Kitchen Supplies

- 1. Plastic to line bathtub
- 2. Water jugs
- 3. Bottle opener
- 4. Disposable dishes and utensils
- 5. Camp stove
- 6. Manual can opener
